Last year tax rates and income brackets (2025)



For income earned in: **2025**



Applied to: **2025 tax return** (to be filed in 2026)

Provincial or territorial income tax rates apply **in addition to** federal income tax rates. The tax rates are split up into income brackets. Each rate applies only to the corresponding income bracket, not to all income.

The rate is determined by the Government of Canada.

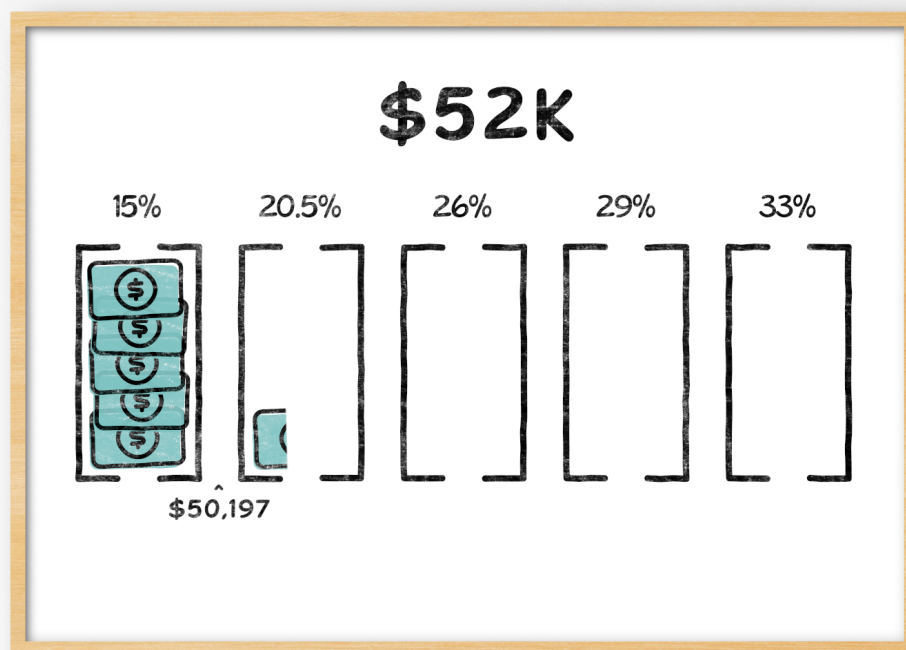
